Smith made the motion, with a second from Bentley, to allow the Beautification Committee to transition to a Main Street Program. Smith, Horne and Bentley voted yes. Curry voted no.

A decision on the 441 Well Area was tabled until April so that Horne, Smith and Curry could visit the site. A site visit was scheduled for the following Thursday at 1pm.

Motion was made by Bentley, seconded by Horne, to go into Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Bentley, seconded by Smith to return to Regular Session. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Curry and seconded by Bentley to hire L' Niesha Anderson as City Clerk at a rate of \$15 per hour. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Bentley and seconded by Horne to suspend 9B of the personnel policy to allow Donna Asbell to train the new city clerk at the rate of \$20 per hour. Bentley, Horne and Smith voted yes. Curry voted no. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Bentley and seconded by Smith. Motion carried unanimously.
