Mayor Bacon called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm

Bentley made the motion with a second from Smith to approve the minutes from April 8, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Bentley made the motion with a second from Smith to add the exception to the conflict of interest prohibition as related to the City of Irwinton's Community Development Block Grant award to the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Curry stated the property he owned at 108 Knight Street is currently being used for rental purposes and is occupied by his sister.

L'Niesha Anderson, city clerk, updated council on her training with Courtware and her training progress to date.

Donna Asbell presented the financials for General Fund and made suggestions for changes to specific line items. (see attached changes to line items)

Smith made the motion with a second from Bentley to amend the 2018-2019 budget per Asbell's suggestions. Motion carried unanimously.

Smith made the motion with a second from Curry to allocate up to \$10,000 from SPLOST 2013 to clear several trees on Asbell, Knight and Church Street. Prior to receiving bids, Georgia Power is to be contacted for possible tree removal at no cost to the city. Bids will be available at June's council meeting, if GA Power is unable to remove trees. Motion carried unanimously.

Main Street was asked to help facilitate the tree removal process.

Improvements to 441 Well Area were tabled until June 11, 2019, at the regular council meeting.

Bentley made the motion with a second from Smith to purchase a mower not exceed \$9000.00 with funds from SPLOST 2007. Curry and Horne voted no. Smith and Bentley voted yes. Mayor voted yes to break the tie. Motion carried.

Bentley made the motion with a second from Smith to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
