Bentley made the motion with a second from Curry to approve the minutes from July 9, 2019 and the budget workshop minutes from July 25, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Anderson and Asbell gave updates on financials.

Asbell gave an update on clerk training.

Bentley made the motion with a second from Curry to authorize the Mayor to sign the SPLOST Referendum with the following allocation: water and sewer projects- 85,000, Public Safety-84,000, Roads, Streets and Bridges- 85,000, Industrial and Economic- 30,000, Administrative Buildings-20,000, Library- 20,000, Cemetery- 10,000, Animal Control-10,000 Recreation- 40,000. Motion carried unanimously.

HighTide upgrade tabled.

Bentley made the motion with a second from Smith to reallocate the money that was assigned for the removing of the trees be used for clearing the right-of- ways. Smith, Bentley and Horne voted yes. Curry voted no. Motion carried with a 3 to 1 vote.

Bentley discussed signs that he identified that needs to be replaced and digital speed limit signs. He also discussed tasking Main Street to develop a comprehensive plan with support from DCA.

Mayor discussed EPD Water Testing increase.

Smith discussed the office hours and personnel.

Asbell gave a presentation on the Drone for the Police Department.

Bentley made the motion with a second from Smith to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
